Kindergarten

- 12 #2 pencils

- 1 watercolor paint set
- 1 box colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 bottle Elmer's liquid glue
- 1 ruler, marked with inches and centimeters
- 1 compass/protractor set (4th-5th only)
- 3 Laboratory/Composition notebooks
- 3 packages of 8.5 x 11 Graph paper (180 pages total) or send \$5 to classroom teacher to provide graph paper
- 1 pair scissors, blunt tip (RoseArt suggested)
