Scappoose Adventist School Emergency Preparedness Plan-Confirmed Case of COVID-19

- 1. Confirm the reported case of an infected person from your campus by obtaining documentation of a positive test result for the virus or confirmation by your Local Public Health Association (LPHA).
- 2. Work with your School Safety Officer to follow the protocol as listed in the *Planning and Responding to COVID-19 Scenarios in Schools*.
- 3. Notify your local superintendent.
- 4. Provide cohort logs to LPHA, to assist with identifying exposed individuals. LPHA will assist the school in determining and notifying exposed individuals.
- 5. Discourage all extracurricular activities and gatherings of staff, students and their families-both private and public during the time of cohort or school closure.
- 6. Notify your school community and anyone who the infected person may have had exposure to. The definition of exposure is being within 6 feet of a COVID-19 case for 15 minutes (or longer).
- 7. Evacuate any areas where the infected person was. Before cleaning, open all doors and windows and wait at least 24 hours before initiating a thorough cleaning and disinfection of the area.

 - To reduce the risk of asthma, choose disinfectant products on the EPA List N with asthma-safer ingredients (e.g. hydrogen peroxide, citric acid, or lactic acid) and avoid products that mix these with asthma-causing ingredients like peroxyacetic acid, sodium hypochlorite (bleach), or quaternary ammonium compounds.
- 8. Continue to utilize the *Planning and Responding to COVID-19 Scenarios in Schools* and collaborate with local health officials as needed.
